### Lesson Activities

**Objective/Goal:** Finish the L'Inglesina Story started before break. Once finished please click the Children's Story Book Assignment

Storytelling through music is a chance for the students to practice creative writing and drawing. It also allows students to listen to music differently. Many people find music without words boring and pointless. With this assignment, we hope to try changing this view.

**Activity/Outline:** Students will be creating a six page story book based on the list of songs provided with that assignment. This is to complete the unit that we are working on.

- Day one: Pick a song and write down the title.
- Day two: break down the song into six time codes. This will indicate when to turn the page for the reader. Please write down the time codes you decide on to avoid confusion
- Day three-four: write a rough draft of your story and turn it in in google docs
- Day four-five: watch the video that will be attached to the assignment to create a book.
- Day five: **Leave the front cover blank.** Write the revised version of your story in the pages. Make sure that time codes are provided in the bottom corners of the pages.
