

Spring 2025 LSUS Dual Enrollment- Deadline to Apply- January 10, 2025

Courses Available (teacher, high school course name and college course name)

Algood- Precalculus- MATH 123: Precalculus (3 credits)

Algood- Statistics- MATH 210: Applied Statistics (3 credits)

Algood- Calculus- MATH 221: Analytic Geometry and Calculus I (3 credits)

Bailey- Advanced Math- Math 122 Plane Trigonometry (3 credits)

Carberry- English IV AP- ENGL 205: Survey British Lit (3 credits)

Jefferson-Physics I Honors- PHYS 251 **AND** 251L: General Physics/General Physics Lab (4 credits)

Jefferson- Physics AP- PHYS 261 **AND** 261L: General Physics for Science Majors/Lab work for Science Majors (4 credits)

Strong- Human Anatomy- BIOS 284 **AND** BIOS 284L (4 credits): Human Anatomy and Physiology/Lab

Minimum Criteria for Enrollment

1. Students must be on track for completing the TOPS University Curriculum
2. Students must have an A or B in the first semester course for which they plan to apply
3. Student must have a 2.5 cumulative gpa on a 4.0 scale
4. ACT composite score of at least 19 *and* ACT English score of at least 18 *and* ACT Math score of 19; for all science courses the ACT math subscore must be at least 21*

See Mrs. Byrd or Mrs. Lacy if you do not meet the testing criteria, but would still like to enroll in dual enrollment courses.

Application Instructions

Returning DE Students: (Students who enrolled in a DE course at LSUS **Fall 2024**)

- 1) Complete the docusign at the following link:

- 2) Be sure to enter your parent's e-mail address correctly. Your parent will receive a link to sign electronically. Make sure they only approve the course you will be taking for dual credit (tell them not to check all boxes on the page)
- 3) Print page two of the docusign and have your teacher initial approval for the course.
- 4) Submit the docusign page to your counselor in the Counseling Office.

New DE Students:

Step 1

- 1) Go to <https://apply.lsus.edu/>
- 2) Select "Start Application" if you have never completed an application for LSUS. Select "Sign In" if you were enrolled in dual enrollment courses at LSUS **during the 23-24 school year.**
- 3) Choose "Dual Enrollment Application"
- 4) Follow the steps to complete and submit the application. Select Spring 2025 for the application term.

If you took dual enrollment courses at LSUS during the 2023-2024 school year (junior year) you must complete the application using the e-mail address used the previous year. Contact Jennie Bynog with any questions- 318-797-5058 or jennie.bynog@lsus.edu. Do NOT WAIT until the last day to do this.

Step 2- submit the dual enrollment registration/course selection via Docusign. This link will be sent to you after you submit the LSUS application (15 minute delay) If you do not receive the link, contact Jennie Bynog jennie.bynog@lsus.edu; (318)797-5058)

- 1) Be sure to enter your parent's e-mail address correctly. Your parent will receive a link to sign electronically. Make sure they only approve the course you will be taking for dual credit (tell them not to check all boxes on the page)

- 3) Submit the docusign page to your counseling in the Counseling Office.

Reminder- if you are taking a course that also has a lab,(all science courses) you and your parent must sign both courses on the course selection document. All forms must be signed electronically. You cannot print and sign manually.
