Welcome & Connections

Meeting opened with greetings and community check-ins.

Review of CEP Goals (2025–2026)

Priority 1 — Literacy

- Goal: Increase ELA proficiency from 38% → 48% by June 2026.
- Increase Acadience benchmark proficiency from 22% → 32%.

Priority 2 — Safety & Wellness

Reduce A24 OOR incidents from 55.7% → 50%.

Priority 3 — High-Quality Academics

Increase Math proficiency (Levels 3 & 4) from 50% → 60%.

Priority 4 — College & Career Readiness

• Increase participation in CS/Robotics/Coding from $0.85\% \rightarrow 85\%$ (Grades 4–5 integrated through Amplify Science).

Priority 5 — Family Engagement

• Increase in-person family event participation from $50\% \rightarrow 60\%$.

Attendance Goal

- Reduce chronic absenteeism in: PK: 50% → 45%, K: 43% → 38%
- Ms. Conklin's announcements during the day have been helpful in reporting accuracy of student absence. Noting the number of reported absences drops during the day.

SWD Goals

- Reduce students not making IEP progress from 10% → 5%.
- Reduce initial referrals from $4.3\% \rightarrow 2.4\%$.

- Tier 1, 2, and 3 instruction evident across classrooms. (ELA/Literacy Focused)
- SPIRE intervention observed.

Intervention Updates

- SPIRE launched for Grades 1–5; materials now in-house.
- Progress monitoring started for Grades 1–2; Grades 3–5 begin in December.

Intervention Schedule

- Selected students receive 25 min of reading intervention, 4 days/week.
- Programs used: Sounds Sensible and SPIRE.
- Some students also receive after-school intervention (1.5 hrs, 3 days/week).

Data tables shared for Grades 3–5 projected proficiency levels and K–2 MAP levels.

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Math ILT Look-Fors

- Discussion of IM "Talking Tool" to support academic discourse.
- IM Lesson Look-Fors reviewed (e.g., student reasoning, task implementation).
