Summary

General Information

The Scoreboost for the GED® Test series of workbooks are condensed presentations of the concepts covered on the GED® tests. It is best suited for students who need minimal instruction and practice to refresh their understanding. Two workbooks are dedicated to language arts (reading and writing), four workbooks cover math topics, and two workbooks, described as Thinking Skills, incorporate scenarios in various presentation formats that address concepts covered in reading, math, science, and social studies.

The publisher lists the reading level of these print resources as 9+.

Organizational Format

Each workbook in the series starts with a table of contents that outlines the workbook's units and lessons. A lesson is referred to as a strategy. Each unit also has a two-page practice test. At the end of the workbook, there is a GED® practice test and an answer key with explanations for all questions throughout the workbook.

A section titled "Item Types on the GED® Test" reviews the various formats of the questions on the GED® test for that subject. Examples are also provided. In addition, students may practice GED® test questions in the various electronic formats on the New Reader Press Online Learning Portal. Students are required to create login credentials on this site. The same unit review questions that are in the print resource are available online. Both the print and online versions of the unit test have a Scoreboost action plan which aids in determining the topics that need further review. The 2nd Edition resources include a feature noted as TESTWISE, which offers test-taking tips.

Lesson Overview

Each strategy is a two-page presentation. The first page presents the concept/topic, followed by an example with a step-by-step solution process. Next is a question labeled GED Problem® (or a label appropriate to the type of question) with the same format. Think comments are provided to aid the student through the solution process. On the second page, titled Apply the Strategy, there are primarily multiple choice questions for the student to answer.

Question/Answer Format

The strategy and unit test questions may be based on text, data, graphs, charts, etc., depending upon the subject. The GED® practice test at the end of the workbook typically consists of about 25 multiple choice questions for the four Math workbooks and a varying number of questions for the Language Arts and Thinking Skill workbooks. The Language Arts and Thinking Skills workbooks also include questions that require short answers or extended responses. The unit tests and GED® practice tests each have a Scoreboost action plan. Each workbook's answer key provides explanations with the answers.
