Open in Prayer, Welcome & Introductions

Review of Life Group Guidelines

Hook Question:

If you could have dinner with one person, who would it be and where would you go?

Background of tonight' story:

JESUS, knowing His time on Earth will soon come to an end, gathers with His disciples for one last supper. There, He does something that takes the disciples by surprise; He begins to wash their feet. However, washing feet is something only done by servants and slaves; never by a master for his own subjects. As we read today's verses, keep in mind what JESUS was trying to teach us through this meaningful act. Think about what this says about His character and how much He truly loves us.

Tell the Story: This week's Bible passage is found in **John 13:1-17**

Rebuild the Story

Read the Story out loud (look for additions or omissions)

Questions:

- Even to the last hours of His life, knowing one of His followers will betray Him, JESUS was setting examples for His disciples. What example did JESUS show here?
- What do you think JESUS meant by the instruction "you ought to wash one another's feet" in verse 14? Do you believe you have been applying this principle in your life?
- In what ways does JESUS' example inspire you to change your character?
- Think about the examples you'd like to have set for those around you. If it's something difficult for you to do, what steps will you take to get yourself there?
