Course Eligibility

In order to ensure students are prepared for the rigor and course load of a college level class there are strict guidelines for admittance to College in the Schools classes at Annandale High School:

- Juniors must be in the top $\frac{1}{3}$ of their class
 - **SCSU Eligibility:** OR have a 3.5 GPA OR [meet test score requirements](#)
 - **SMSU Eligibility:** OR have a 3.0 GPA OR score in the 70th percentile of nationally recognized standardized test
- Seniors must be in the top $\frac{1}{2}$ of their class
 - **SCSU Eligibility:** OR have a 3.0 GPA OR [meet test score requirements](#)
 - **SMSU Eligibility:** OR have a 3.0 GPA OR score in the 50th percentile of nationally recognized standardized test

- *Sophomores must be in the top 10% of their class
 - **SCSU Eligibility:** OR have a 3.75 GPA OR [meet test score requirements](#)
 - **SMSU Eligibility:** OR have a 3.5 GPA OR score in the 90th percentile of nationally recognized standardized test

Class rank and percentile can be found on the student transcript in Campus under Documents.

ACCUPLACER

St. Cloud State University's program has additional requirements for participation in the English 191 - Intro to Rhetorical & Analytical Writing course. Their accreditation requires all students to take the ACCUPLACER Next Generation Reading placement test and score a 250 or higher. *All College Composition students will take this test within the first week of the semester, unless you can provide an ACT score of 18+ on the English section OR 21+ on the Reading section.*

Appeals

Students who register for college level courses but **do not** meet these requirements should discuss the appeals process with their counselor. The college appeals committee will ultimately decide if the student is allowed to take the course.

- Appeals for fall semester College in the Schools classes are due in May
- Appeals for spring semester College in the Schools classes are due in November

Application

Students taking College in the Schools classes through SCSU or SMSU will apply to the Huskies in the High School and/or College Now programs with the school counselors in the spring. All students will *register* with the teacher for each course the first week of the semester during class.
