### “Close the Gaps in Tree Protection, Pass a Better TPO”

Trees Atlanta urges you to support the approval of the TPO. We recommend: Vote YES and approve the May 1 TPO. Now is the time to call and email Atlanta City Council.

The work has been long and complex, and the City should be recognized for continuing to move the process forward for the protection and benefit of the people.

We cannot wait any longer for Atlanta to pass a better TPO to protect peoples' health and wellbeing.
