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New Business

- Futsal discussion
 - Kevin K – traffic on 52nd
 - PBOTs slow streets on 53rd
 - not a problem
 - What else
 - auto parts store
 - Futsal
 - good neighborhood agreements from 2013/12/5
 - when they started
 - Kevin K
 - increase in traffic over 22 years
 - change to 53rd

- also increase in trucks
- Agreement: section 4, supposed to direct people over the bridge
- What do you tell members, delivery drivers, what could be done to mitigate?
- Kevin M.
 - Why is 52nd impacted?
 - neighbors: because of 53rd blocks, not all futsal
 - delivery is not like pre-covid
 - people are coming out multiple times, more than before
 - food, gas, (not Brinks trucks)
- Carly
 - delivery trucks and general traffic
 - neighbors: general more traffic in the evenings
 - games are 6:30 to 11:20
 - but staggered every 20 minutes
 - so should be a hum
 - amount of people coming to games shouldn't have changed, but maybe more individual cars more?
 - member-based, so now one else at the pub
 - only 2 service trucks per week, and one cleaning truck
 - remainder would be clients
 - don't know where they are coming from exactly
 - but pretty broad
 - pretty small staff
 - 10-4pm arrival
 - with new facility in Tigard, there should be less
- Kevin M
 - about every 2 years they do education programs
 - could add language to guide people in/out
 - there is signage to be quiet and slow
 - but mostly dealing with vandalism these days
 - paraphernalia
- Carly
 - they don't spend the night here like neighbors do
 - how can they help the neighbors and vice versa
- Kelly
 - trash

- not from neighbors
- Chris
 - lots of elementary kids in neighborhood and do go to futsal
 - people late to games seem to race down streets
 - could use street lines
- Laura King
 - After school?
 - 4-6pm 2-8th grade academy
 - weekends?
 - not as much spring and fall
 - in the winter there's 13 hours of games on 40 games, 80 teams, 5-8 people per team
 - One car taking 4 trips to come and go at beginning and end
 - lots of speeding
 - Need more stop signs and lines, crosswalks
- Kevin K
 - how long are games?
 - about 50 minutes
- Kevin M
 - maybe a tipping point of 53rd, because there is not been any change in people
- Terry
 - PBOT likes to squeeze traffic down
 - 53rd and other things push more cut-through traffic
- Kip
 - any recent traffic counts?
- Laura
 - PBOT put the counters in poor places where people speed
 - and put it on a holiday, so "no problem on your streets"
 - did not adequately reflect traffic issues
- Kip
 - Where are vehicles coming from?
 - mostly from Halsey
- Sharron
 - We were here when Futsal started
 - lots of concessions to bend over backwards
 - but since beginning, traffic has been an issue and speeding issues

- this is not a new problem
 - people are here tonight out of exasperation
- Kevin M
 - will co-communicate with PBOT
 - Kelly: try to get them here all together
- Terry
 - lots of graffiti, but try to take care of it quickly
- Carly
 - neighbor between them and crematorium
 - there is a city lot at the back, but gets lots of issues
 - sometimes homeless
- adequate parking?
 - winter weekend youth leagues
 - can be the biggest challenge
 - lots of people want to park outside of lot
 - people late and leaving, speed through, no stopping at stop sign to get out towards Irving
- Terry
 - Is there worry about vandalism in lot?
 - back parking
- Joe
 - People parking on street also gather and make noise
 - Providence Hospital too, vibrates HVAC, emergency generators
 - who did study on 53rd?
 - PBOT
- Chris
 - get people to stop going fast, and stop at signs
 - give out yellow cards!
- Kevin M
 - speed guns?
- Carly
 - She lives in Oregon City, is trying to deal with speeding herself
 - wants to work in partnership to help with the issue

- speed signs don't work
 - maybe deal with some visibility issues?
- Terry
 - just more stop signs?
- Chris
 - 52nd and Wasco
 - People ignore that one and build speed from there
- Laura
 - lots of flooring all the way down
 - just need a couple stop signs
 - Terry: this should be low cost
- Ben
 - Speed bumps don't help
- Kelly
 - We'll reach out PBOT
 - Futsal should educate patrons
 - traffic, speed, routes, music
- Susan
 - Where's the enforcement?
 - Chris: police just re-started traffic 4 months ago
- 7:50 Futsal people left
- Post-discussion
- Minutes
 - Terry: Halsey project
 - they are preparing to do changes
 - Approved unanimously

- Clay Thompson – Tri-Met –
 - Service changes for Hollywood HUB
 - On the phone
 - Presentation on Kelly's laptop
 - August 23, Transit Service changes
 - they do it 4 times a year
 - trying to extend and improve connections for
 - lots of changes in services post-covid
 - the first big one to deal with it
 - more than just the Hollywood Hub
 - Line 66
 - Hollywood to OHSU
 - poor ridership, along with other OHSU lines
 - will be canceled
 - temporary
 - 75 and 77
 - due to construction
 - moving to NE 42nd and Halsey
 - will take down ramp, with construction in November
 - 75 N will stop in front of BlueFin
 - 77 E will move to in front of Halsey parking garage
 - 75 S and 77 E will stop in front of Trader Joe's
 - Other extensions next year and frequencies
 - Terry
 - is frequency the same?
 - yes
 - Susan
 - brochures at libraries?
 - yes, will do this and Trader Joes
 - Kip
 - would Trimet reach out to us?
 - Kelly: probably not since not directly in neighborhood
- 64th and Brazee
 - planters
 - Scott: design is approved,
 - between October – January will be installed
- Businesses on Sandy
 - will table this until Laura is here
 - concerned with empty storefronts on Sandy

 - Kimberly Ruffo is new contact
 - Kelly sent her questions
 - sidewalk infrastructure
 - golf trail
 - Metro's money but PPR's administration
 - Sharron:
 - no information on what they are doing, they were shocked the money came in so quickly
 - Terry: they might have info at the golf course event
