

Subject: Supporting Long-Term Stability for Ukrainians Residing in Canada

Dear [Member of Parliament's Name],

I am writing to you as a Canadian citizen to raise an urgent issue that affects thousands of Ukrainians who have been living in Canada for several years under temporary measures and who now face growing uncertainty about their future.

Canada responded swiftly and generously when Ukrainians arrived seeking safety. Since that time, many have moved well beyond initial settlement. They are employed across essential sectors, operate small businesses, contribute to the tax base, and are raising children who now consider Canada their home. These individuals are not transient visitors; they are embedded members of our communities.

It has therefore been deeply concerning to learn that, despite their length of stay and level of integration, many Ukrainians in Canada face the possibility of having to leave because they do not fit within existing Immigration categories. In particular, a significant number do not meet the eligibility criteria of current Economic Immigration streams due to factors such as age thresholds, language-testing requirements, credential recognition barriers, gaps in Canadian work experience, or family circumstances. These limitations do not reflect a lack of contribution or commitment, but rather structural constraints within programs that were not designed to address prolonged Humanitarian displacement.

I respectfully submit that this moment presents an opportunity for Canada to act in a manner consistent with both its Humanitarian principles and long-term National Interests. Establishing a dedicated and transparent pathway to Permanent Residence for Ukrainians currently living in Canada would recognize their contributions, provide certainty for families, and reinforce Canada's reputation as a country that values responsibility, fairness, and integration.

I would appreciate receiving your written position on this matter, including whether you support the development of a special Permanent Residence program and what steps, if any, you intend to take. I plan to share your response with other Canadians who are actively engaged in advocating for a constructive and compassionate solution.

This correspondence reflects the views of a Canadian citizen who fully supports this request and believes that providing long-term stability to Ukrainians in Canada is both the right and responsible course of action.
