

Student Code of Conduct

(Athletic Responsibility Acknowledgement)

As a San Pasqual Valley High School student-athlete, who is participating voluntarily in interscholastic athletics, I understand that my participation is a privilege and dependent on my acceptance of the following expectations:

Initials of Acknowledgement

BULLYING/HARASSMENT/HAZING: Guardian _____ Student-Athlete _____

1. I will not use abusive and/or offensive language, insults, teasing, or unreasonable criticism.
2. I will not use or participate in physical abuse or intimidation of another student.
3. I will not use technology, my peers or other means to bully, harass, or haze another student.

SUBSTANCE ABUSE: Guardian _____ Student-Athlete _____

4. I will not use or be in possession of alcohol, tobacco, or any illegal substance. Failure to comply with this will result in my immediate dismissal or suspension from the sport in which I am participating.

ELIGIBILITY: Guardian _____ Student-Athlete _____

5. I will at all times maintain a satisfactory academic eligibility standing by passing all classes in which I am enrolled with the highest grades possible in each subject area. Failure to do so will result in my suspension from game competition on a week to week basis.
6. Academic Eligibility is a minimum of 2.00 or "C" GPA during the grading period. If a student is ineligible due to being below a **2.0 OR** receives an "**F**" they will miss the current weeks games, and go on monitored eligibility. In which they will turn in weekly grade checks to the office for the current grading period, attend two tutoring sessions in place of practice, and will not be permitted to travel. Once their grade check shows improvement to meet eligibility athlete will be reviewed by Principal and Athletic Director to determine if they can return to game play.

ATTENDANCE: Guardian _____ Student-Athlete _____

7. I will attend all my classes and practices each and every day. I will be in full attendance on the day of the game unless excused by a doctor, court appointment, or other approved absence.
8. Student-Athletes must maintain a 90% attendance to include the 1st period full day attendance for the totality of the preceding weeks of the current school year. Failure to qualify due to attendance, must be made up through Saturday School participation.

CITIZENSHIP: Guardian _____ Student-Athlete _____

9. I will be a good citizen and conduct myself in an exemplary manner at all times so as not to bring discredit or embarrassment to me personally, my parents, my team, and my school. Failure to comply with this expectation may result in suspension or dismissal from the game or team depending on the severity of my actions.

RESPONSIBILITY Guardian _____ Student-Athlete _____

10. I will be responsible for all athletic equipment issued to me, will return such equipment in good condition and will pay the current replacement cost for any equipment not returned by me at the end of the season. Failure to return equipment or pay the current replacement cost will result in my disqualification from participation in further athletic events.
