

Three Generations of Glass Blowers in the Roaring Fork Valley: Starting in 1990, Spiro Lyon Glass was founded by Jacqueline Spiro and Lee Lyon. Spiro initially worked for Lyon to learn the craft as his apprentice. In 1993, Spiro met her husband, Aspen native, Dylan Balderson, who joined the team and brought experience in glassblowing and an expertise in woodworking. In 2010, Lyon retired and handed over the business to Spiro and Balderson. Years later, one of their students, TJ Ossola (also a native of the Roaring Fork Valley) took the role as Lead Blower/Gaffer. For 29 years, Spiro Lyon has explored the many aspects of glass for use in design, sculpture, craft, and architecture; glass blowing, glass casting and glass sculpture for homes, furniture, interior or exterior design and landscaping features.
