


Hello! Thank you so much for inquiring about camping at Cal-Wood. Here is our camping pricing guide - please reach out to retreats@calwood.org with any questions.

Campsites:

We currently have four campsites available (we have two other campsites in the burnzone which cannot be used right now, but we are hoping to have one of the two ready to go for Summer 2026 - stay tuned!)



Aspen Glen -

- Capacity: 25 tents/75 people
- From June-September <u>Cal-Wood's Family Camp Program</u> uses this campsite, this means:
 - We have 12 large canvas tents set up which comfortably sleep 6 people each

- This site is only available on the weekdays
- o There are 3 porta potties and a handwashing station available for use
- Bear bins and trash cans are available year round

Solitude -

- Capacity: 20 tents/60 people
- Permanent outhouse
- Bear bins and trash cans are available year round
- Lightning shelter onsite

Outpost -

- Capacity: 20 tents/60 people
- Permanent outhouse
- Bear bins and trash cans are available year round
- Lightning shelter onsite
- Booked from June-August

Rec Field (only available if you are also booking space in the cabins or Meckley)-

- Capacity: 20 tents/60 people
- Short walk to the lodge for restrooms
- Food storage available in the lodge

Pricing:

Land Use -

- 10 or fewer people \$150/night
- 11-29 people \$250/night
- 30+ people \$350/night

Firewood - \$10/24 hours

• If we are in a fire ban or you will not be making a campfire during your stay, we will remove this charge. Please do not bring your own firewood into Cal-Wood

Lodge and Shower Access - \$30-50/day

- Shower access is \$30/day (rate may vary depending on size of group), if you would like to include lodge access as well the rate will be \$50/day
- Lodge use is not guaranteed with your camping stay, please inquire about this with the Retreat Coordinator prior to booking.
- The timing of this will need to be negotiated based on the schedules of the other groups onsite, the Retreat Coordinator will let you know when it is appropriate for your participants to access the showers and indoor lodge space.
- This does not need to be purchased for the duration of your trip, you can decide how many days you would like to add-on shower access. (i.e. if you are staying at Cal-Wood Monday-Friday, but only want to shower on Tuesday and Thursday we would charge \$60 rather than \$100)

Programming (Optional Add-On) - \$30/hour/instructor + \$1.50/participant/24 hours to cover accident insurance

Meals: Meals are not included in your camping rental, if you would like to add any meals to your stay please contact <u>retreats@calwood.org</u>

Nature & Adventure Based Programs led by our staff:

Our expert staff is qualified to lead the following activities at \$30/hour per instructor: (we aim for a 1:12 instructor to participant ratio to ensure quality and safe experiences. This may vary depending on the age range of the participants.)

<u>Guided Day Hikes</u> - This is what we do best! With over 1,200 acres of land and 3-miles of trails, our instructors can lead you through this beautiful landscape across creeks, on top of mountain peaks, through fields and valleys and even amazing mountain vistas.

<u>Guided Mindfulness Walk</u> - Join our nature mindfulness guide on a slow-paced wander through a beautiful area of Cal-Wood, and leave feeling refreshed and relaxed. We'll take our time exploring and connecting with nature together through sensory experiences, creative and playful activities, and quiet reflection. Let us customize a memorable and inspiring experience based on your group's goals!

<u>Guided Night Hikes</u> - Using only the stars, moon and the knowledge of the land, let our instructors guide you on a night hike where we can: teach astronomy, lead games teaching about nocturnal wildlife & eyesight, and/or lead solo hikes or silent sits on this unique experience without lights.

<u>Colorado History w/Pioneer Cabin</u> - On our property we have a cabin built in 1901 where people who acquired land from the Homestead Act lived off the land many years ago. Cal-Wood is booming with homestead and mining history. Choose to explore our pioneer cabin combined with a history lesson or a hike to nearby mining exploration pits!

<u>Archery</u> - Take a lesson on how to shoot a bow & arrow combined with free time to practice shooting targets and an optional competition at the end! Activity for any age. (Seasonal) (please allocate 2 hours for this activity)

<u>Fishing</u> - Take a fishing lesson for any age and practice in our pond that gets fully stocked every summer. (Seasonal)

<u>Survival Skills</u> - Learn how to build fires, shelters and navigate using a map and compass. Work in teams to practice these skills and even an optional competition at the end!

<u>Team-Building</u> - Let us know your goals whether it be ice breakers, fun games, building communication, team bonding or team challenges; our staff can put together a unique program to build long-lasting relationships and strong team bonds.

<u>Orienteering</u> - Learn how to use a map and compass and navigate our orienteering course like a scavenger hunt, finding 8 different points on a map to complete the challenge. Work together as a team or individually as a competition!

<u>Campfire</u> - Our staff has a repertoire of campfire songs and skits to make a fun-filled classic camp-style evening around the campfire. (Fire-Ban dependent)

<u>Tree Climbing</u> - Led by Tree Climbers Colorado, this magical experience includes learning how to climb a tree with a harness and rope, with the opportunity to experience what it's like to be up in a tree, climbing branches, and seeing the world from an entirely new perspective. The certified leaders also provide a wealth of knowledge about trees and their importance in our environment. *** This activity is priced independently at \$45/person

<u>Rock Climbing</u> - A new and exciting addition to Cal-Wood's offerings- an opportunity for participants to learn and experience rock climbing guided by our certified instructors. This is an awesome opportunity to experience hands-on time in nature, learn to trust yourself and your guide, and catch some beautiful views of our 1200 acres. *This activity is priced at \$45/person, if this is cost prohibitive please reach out!
