In Haiti, she enjoyed extending hospitality to guests and helping them find their way around Port-au-Prince. She was very involved in the kids' school, serving on the parent committee, helping in the classrooms, and substitute teaching for several grades. Julie relies on <a href="Philippians 4:13">Philippians 4:13</a>, "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." She shares, "Often I find myself feeling as if I can't do anything more and it is the strength, love, and joy of my Savior that spurs me on."




# Mark & Holly Woodard,

Iran Alive Ministries uses Satellite TV and modern technology to reach Iranians with the saving Gospel of Jesus Christ. Although there are no physical buildings, the Church is blossoming in Iran as the Gospel is shared, new believers are discipled and trained up. God is transforming Iran, one soul at a time!

The ministry began in 2000 and was founded by Dr. Hormoz Shariat after God had given him a deep conviction to reach his fellow Iranians with the Gospel. Iran has the fastest growing Evangelical population.

Currently, Iran Alive Ministry channel is the number one most watched Christian channel in Iran with an estimated 6 million daily viewers. Iran Alive has planted a network of hundreds of underground churches in over 90 cities in Iran, as well as churches in Europe and California.

Since December 31, 2022 over 13,510 people have accepted Christ as their Savior. This brings the total number of documented salvation to over 89,219 since the inception of Iran Alive Ministries. Each of these new believers risked their lives to contact us in order to let us know of their faith in Jesus.
