_This information is provided by your orchestra teacher to help you decide your summer activities. Please check the prices and dates, as we do not guarantee accuracy. Some camps are just day camps, while others are boarding camps, and some offer both. Please contact your orchestra teacher if you have any questions.

Remember that summer camps are not the only enrichment opportunity. Many professional and high school musicians in the area offer private lessons which can keep skills high and can accelerate the student past his/her peers. Private instructors will have new music to learn that is geared specifically for your instrument. You can request to learn some cool tunes like movie theme songs, or songs from your favorite band! Contact your orchestra teacher for a listing of professional and high school private teachers.

Resident Campers: \$650 (includes shared room/bath, all meals, tuition, recreation)

Commuter: \$525 (includes lunch, dinner, tuition, recreation)

Private lessons: \$35 per half hour

MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS:

Must have at least two years of study and ensemble experience on your concert band or orchestral string instrument prior to camp. [Ensemble director's recommendation will be requested.](#)

Suzuki Strings: Students should have a minimum of two years of instruction playing grade three repertoire in their school programs and youth orchestras or the equivalent of Suzuki Book 4 for violinist and Suzuki Book 3 for violists, cellists and basses.

Must be age 12 on or before June 1.

Talented musicians from across the country join together on the beautiful Furman campus to build not only musicianship skills but life-long friendships. For ages 12-18, the students perform in one of four large ensembles (a full symphony orchestra, a string orchestra, and two concert bands) and may audition for a jazz ensemble, various chamber groups, or perform as a soloist on the Honors Solo Recital. In addition to the ensemble rehearsals, sectionals, and master classes, the camp offers courses in basic musicianship, conducting, yoga for musicians and history.
