History of Domaine:

Situated in the heart of the Loire Valley, the Domaine de la Grézille benefits from the temperate climate of the Anjou region. The combination of a privileged climate with the famous tuffeau-stone and shell marl subsoil gives their wines their unique terroir personality. Their traditional and careful approach to growing wines reinforces the grapes natural potential. All of their decisions are based on biological balance and all vinification is natural without additives.

Cuvée:

Les Quartz

Grape Variety:

100% Cabernet Sauvignon (50-year-old-vines)

Soil:

Clay-Limestone, Subsoil: Falun and Tuffeau

Yield:

60 Hl/H

Vinification:

Manual harvest and methode traditionnelle, two fermentations, using native yeasts only. 15-day maceration, 4 to 5 months aging on lees. Second fermentation in bottles on laths for one year. Cellar aging for 2 years.
