

1. Moderator Script

[This script is to conduct **remote moderated** usability studies which focus on the user's experience logging, reviewing, searching, and rating movies on the Letterboxd website. Therefore, before the test, please ensure the participants' technology is functioning.]

1.1 Introduction & Greeting

Hello [NAME], how are you?

My name is [NAME], and I'll be walking you through today's testing session. [NAME] will also join us and will be taking notes during our session. *[If there are observers joining the session.]*

Thank you so much for agreeing to participate in Letterboxd website usability test today. As you may already be aware, our objective is to gain insight into the ease of use of the Letterboxd website.

1.2 Consent to Record

Before we start, I would like to ask you whether you have received and completed the consent form for the audio/video recording for today's session. It should have been sent to you along with the email invitation.

1.3 Session Agenda

Let me guide you through today's session agenda.

First, I'd like to request that you provide some basic information about yourself. Then, we'll go through a series of tasks to be performed using Letterboxd's website. There will be some scenarios for you to carry out the way you usually do without anyone watching you.

In the end, we'd like to talk about your experience and feelings while using Letterboxd desktop website and I'll ask you to fill out another short questionnaire. The session will take about 30 minutes.

1.4 Let participants know to feel free to share

Throughout the session, you're welcome to express your thoughts, feelings and experiences. I want you to know that there is no right or wrong answer to any question. **We are not testing you, we are testing the system and even if you are not able to complete any task it's not you it's the systems fault.** Please do not hesitate to share your ideas, either negative or positive. We're very interested in knowing about your experience while using Letterboxd. No matter what you think, you can think out loud.

If you want to take a break or hear the questions again, just let me know and we can stop or repeat. Do you have any questions?

Cool. Let's get started.

1.5 Pre-Test Questionnaires

1.6.2 Scenarios

[Please ask participants the next scenario once they accomplish the previous one.]

Great, now that you are logged in, we'll run through a few scenarios and ask you a few questions. Remember to think out loud as you work through the tasks.

Question: Before we begin, I first wanted to get your initial thoughts on the website. First impressions. What do you see?

Great! Let's start with the first scenario.

Scenario 1:

Add the following movies to your watchlist:

- The Dark Knight (2008)
- M3GAN (2022)

Scenario 2:

Please rate and review “The Dark Knight” (2008) and M3GAN (2022). For the review you can make it up and keep it short.

Scenario 3:

Create a list and give it any name you’d like, and please add the following movies to the list:

- The Dark Knight (2008)
- M3GAN (2022)
- One Hundred and One Nights (1995)

Scenario 4:

Find the list titled “Official Top 250 Narrative Feature Films” and sort by newest released films.

Scenario 5:

Like the review on M3GAN (2022) from the user Kársten

Scenario 6:

You want to receive emails when you get a new follower. How would you do this?

1.7 Post-Test Questionnaires

1.7.1 Post-Test Questionnaires

Questions:

1. How would you describe your overall experience of using Letterboxd?
2. What do you like the most about Letterboxd?
3. What did you find most difficult and why?
4. What (if anything) surprised you while completing your tasks?
5. What (if anything) are some of the changes you would like to see on the website? Why?
6. If you have used any other similar platforms, how would you compare letterbox with the platforms you’ve used before?

1.7.2 The System Usability Scale

Can you please fill out this brief survey for us to measure the overall usability of the website?
