Upcoming Week's Standards...


Reading: Text Features and how they help us understand non-fiction. Main Idea and key details from nonfiction texts. Answering questions in written format.

Writing: Writing chapters and closing for informational writing. Begin the revising/editing process.

Spelling: Unit 16

Math: Adding 3 numbers, solving word problems using strategies.

Social Studies: *Balance and Motion* We will explore the concept of balancing, spin and rotation

 **Homework** ... There is a Non-Fiction reading passage for this week. There are two sheets for math. One asks students to choose the strategy they like to solve word problems. Remind your child to do PISA, write an equation and THEN choose a strategy. Have them write the strategy they choose. The strategies are on the blog if you need to reference them in the "video links" tab. The second one reinforces the concept of switch partners (commutative property). No matter the order two numbers will always equal the same total. $3+4=4+3$.
