AFSA High School Senior Scholarship Contest

Sponsor: American Fire Sprinkler Association (AFSA)

Amount: \$2,000

Closing Date: April 1, 2019

Description: Scholarship is open to high school seniors who are citizens and aliens legally residing in the United States. Applicant must read the "Fire Sprinkler Essay" and then take a ten question multiple-choice test.

Description: Scholarship is open to high school seniors and current full-time college students who will attend college in the 2019-2020 school year. Applicant must be studying an ag-related field and have at least a 2.5 GPA.

Description: Scholarship is open to African-American female students who are graduating high school seniors and have at least a 3.0 GPA. Applicant must submit an essay on a trailblazer of African descent of their choosing.

Description: Scholarship is open to graduating high school seniors who self-identify as LGBTQ or an ally and who is a resident of the state of Nebraska or Western Iowa.
