Yarn: Classic Elite Portland Tweed. Color, 513 Black Forest. These took a little more than 1

skein.

Needles: Size 7 Double Point Needles

Gauge: 5.5 stitches to the inch.

Measurement: 7 inches round, 11 inches long.

Cast on 34 stitches. Divide onto 3 needles. (Needle 1, 12 stitches. Needle 2, 12 stitches, Needle 3, 10 stitches.) Join for working in the round. Knit for 7.5 inches.

Next round, needle 1: Knit 4, slip next 4 stitches onto a piece of waste yarn, CO 4 stitches using the backward loop method, knit to end. Continue knitting in the round until entire piece measures 11 inches. Bind off.

Thumb: Place 4 stitches from waste yarn on a double pointed needle. Pick up and use 4 stitches around thumb opening using another double pointed needle. Using a third dp, pick up and knit 4 more stitches around opening. 12 stitches. Join, working in the round for 1.5 inches. Bind off. Weave in ends.
