## Assignment: Psychology Podcasts Exploring Psychology through Podcasts

**Objective**: Engage with contemporary psychological topics through podcasts and critically analyze the content.

**Part 1**: Podcast Exploration. Select and listen to a podcast episode related to psychology, released within the last 5 years. For ideas, consider these series below.

- Hidden Brain
- Speaking of Psychology
- The Psychology Podcast
- No Stupid Questions
- All in the Mind
- The Happiness Lab
- Choiceology

**Part 2**: Answer the following questions inside the discussion forum. You should enter one of the groups (just to keep the discussion more reasonable in size). These should be detailed:

- 1. What is the title of the podcast and episode you chose? **Provide a link**.
- 2. Summarize the podcast in one or two paragraphs. What would you say was the central idea or thesis of the episode?
- 3. List three memorable points from the podcast.
- 4. What field of psychology does the main idea of your podcast best connect with?
- 5. Would you recommend this podcast? Explain your reasoning.
- 6. Pose a question that arose for you after listening to this episode. What are you still curious about?
- 7. Locate and cite an original research article that is mentioned in the episode. **Include the citation or link**. \*Tip: Check the podcast's resources or use author names/titles to find articles. <u>Library access</u> may be needed.
- 8. Describe the methods used in the research:



- 1. How was the research conducted? If applicable, what were the independent and dependent variables in the study?
- 2. Who were the participants in the research, and what was the sample size?
- 9. Summarize the takeaways from the journal article. What conclusions were reached?
- 10. Is the information in the article what you expected to be there, based on how it was mentioned in the podcast? In what ways is the information the same or different than what you expected to see in the research?

**Part 3**: Return to the discussion board to comment on another post. Try to extend or elaborate on the discussion they started. For example, what did you find interesting, curious, or surprising about what they shared? What else have you heard about this topic already, or what other questions might you have about this topic?
