5 sm groups, no more than 5 students; 3 groups of approximately 15 students 4-5 Flex team

5 sm groups, no more than 6 students; 3 groups of approximately 15 students

- Staff meets to form groups based off of DIBELS assessment data
- Groups will be flexible; once students become proficient in the skill that the group is working on they will move out of that group
- Small groups will be led by classroom teachers and instructional specialists
- Small groups will be focused on a literacy skill to provide instructional support to obtain proficiency
- Parents of students that are in small groups will be initially notified at parent-teacher conferences
- Larger groups will be led by specials teachers, Mr. Ewald, and support staff
- Larger groups will focus on literacy extensions
