Tournament Placings

The tournament will be run through Best Coast Pairings. Players will be required to sign up via the website to be registered for the event AND for pairings/scores. Use the App once signed up (its easier)

Best Painted

The TO will make you aware your army is selected for the "parade". At lunch, please use a table to display your army as best you can. Voting will then be done at lunch before game 2. Please make sure you vote.

4 Armies will be chosen by the TO's. Those 4 armies need to be set up on Table 1 in a quarter of it each for voting.

BEST PAINTED SINGLE MINIATURE - Table 5 will be used to hold Best Painted Single Miniature - Please place your entry and a Label/Stand/Marker showing what the model is and WHO painted it. TO will not provide markers but will have scraps of paper if need be.

You will be using the Games Workshop Chapter Approved : Arks of Omen Grand Tournament rules and missions.

Conduct

- Re roll Cocked dice (not flat).
- Roll Dice where your opponent can see them.
- Re roll dice that land in scenery.
- Re roll dice that fall off the table.
- Ideally, roll into a dice tray.

- Failed dice rolls to be removed leaving successful on the table or in tray to allow opponent to witness successful rolls.
- Ranges to be measured and demonstrated to opponents.
- Intent to be stated at all times if possible, this helps clear any decisions to be made.
- Its loud in the room, make sure your opponent can hear you and what you are doing, speak up.
- Mistakes can be made, we are all human so please be courteous of each other and allow the benefit of the doubt where you can. If serious etiquette concerns are had, please bring to the attention of the TO.

Army Standards

There are NO painting requirements. Max score for each round is 90 points.

Proxies are not allowed without confirmation with TO. There is a big difference between a proxy and a conversion. Please don't take the mick out of the hobby aspect to run meta units. Continuous abuse of this will have consequences.

Terrain

Terrain will consist of a mix of buildings. The terrain will be placed in turn by each player starting with the attacker. All other rules for terrain are to be adhered to. All ruins over 3 inches tall will be Obscuring/Breachable ruins. All other scenery (hills/rocks etc) will be classed as dense terrain/light cover depending on what they are.

We will be marking 1 or more LARGE buildings with Green Tape. This denotes that the buildings ground floor is closed up and you cannot shoot into, or out of that ground floor. This piece of scenery can never be placed within either players deployment zones. It MUST be in no mans land.

Some of our buildings do not have bases, please state intent (Behind the building, in the building) and use a "line" drawn from point to point to determine behind/inside the cover.

When placing terrain - Please ensure all terrain is at least 4 inches from the board edge, and 4 inches from each other piece of terrain.

Question 3 -What is the last mission?

Accessories

Please make sure you bring your wargaming tools. Tape measures and other measuring instruments (3/6/9 inch doofers). Scenery markers, army ability markers, wound tokens, dataslates etc. Your own set of dice (20 should be enough with a few other dice to supplement wound counting, CP tracking etc). A version of your list (digital or physical) to show your opponent. A pen, some lunch/snacks/drinks, a tray to move your army around.

All basic equipment is purchasable from Marionville Models if forgotten.

Please arrive BEFORE registration is over. If you are too late to your first game, we will award a Win to your opponent. You will be allowed to play but it will not count to your overall tournament score.
