


# VUSD Safe and Healthy School Community Expectations

With our return to in-person learning, our first priority is to protect the health, safety and well-being of students, teachers, and other school staff. The below expectations are intended to keep all in our school community safe.

**Applicable to all individuals present on a school campus:**

<b>Face Coverings</b> 	<p>Face Coverings must be worn at all times while on campus &amp; must cover both mouth &amp; nose.</p> <p>Masks may be temporarily removed only when <b>ALL</b> of the following are true:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>You are outdoors (not in hallways)</li> <li>You are standing at least 6 feet from others</li> <li>You are drinking water</li> </ul>	<p>Violation of any face covering expectation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>First Incident:</b> redirection, warning, admin/parent notification, provide face covering (if needed)</li> <li><b>Second Incident:</b> Loss of Privilege (removal from in person learning), admin/parent notification, possible option to return to in person learning</li> <li><b>Third Incident:</b> redirection, warning, admin/parent notification, Loss of Privilege (permanent virtual learning setting)</li> </ul> <p><i><b>*CDPH guidance requires that any student who refuses to wear a face covering must be removed from school and alternative instruction provided, unless the student is exempt from the requirement.</b></i></p>	48900k	COVID Violation ZC
	<p><b>Acceptable Masks and Face Coverings</b></p> <p>When selecting face masks, choose those that have <b>two or more layers of washable and breathable fabric</b>. All masks and acceptable face coverings <b>must cover the nose and mouth</b> of the student or staff and <b>may not contain holes, valves, or mesh material</b>. Gaiters may be worn only if they have two or more layers of fabric or are folded to make two layers. <b><u>Bandanas and scarves without an underlying mask or acceptable face covering are not permitted.</u></b></p> <p>All student masks and face coverings must abide by the school dress code. Student masks and face coverings must adhere to <a href="#">VUSD Board Policy 5132(a)</a> and must not present a health or safety hazard or a distraction which would interfere with the educational process.</p>			

# VUSD Safe and Healthy School Community Expectations

## Bathroom Use



Teachers may allow one student at a time to leave class to use the bathroom.

- Call Front Office
- Campus Supervisor notified
- One student per bathroom
- Waiting Spots

Students are expected to be mindful of personal hygiene and wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds before exiting.

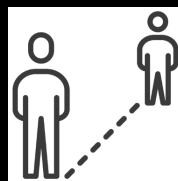
## Food / Water



No food or drink in classrooms.

Teachers may use discretion in permitting one student at a time to go outdoors for water/food during class time.

## Passing Period and Congregating



During passing periods, students must stay at least 6 feet apart, as feasible.

Students must continue to make progress to next class and shall not congregate.

Before or after school, students may not congregate in groups.

Students who are not scheduled to be on campus will be directed to leave.

## Entering rooms/ seating and classroom etiquette



Students should remain 6 feet apart while waiting to enter or upon entering the classroom.

Once inside, students must go directly to seat, unless otherwise indicated by teacher

# VUSD Safe and Healthy School Community Expectations

## Staff Only:

### Visual Health Screen

Staff will conduct visual wellness checks of all students upon arrival.

Students that arrive at school after the start of the school day will follow check-in procedures at the front office which will include visual wellness checks and may include temperature checks.

Signs of illness could include:

- Flushed cheeks
- Shortness of breath or cough
- Rapid breathing or difficult breathing (without recent physical activity)
- Fatigue
- Extreme Irritability

If a student displays signs of infectious illness consistent with COVID-19:

- Staff will excuse the student from the classroom or area within the school and notify the front office staff.
- The school's COVID 19 Point of Contact (or designee) will take the student to a designated isolation room/area until transportation can be arranged to send the student home or to seek medical attention.
