Off-Site, or Commercial Composting ("On-Farm" or "Organics Recycling")

Wide range of acceptable items: most often includes ALL food except liquids: meat, bones, dairy, veggies, fruit, bread, plus paper towels, napkins, fiber lunch trays, paper plates and cups. Up to 89% of the waste from a school lunch can be composted in this manner. *Different from on-site or home composting (animal products.)*
