Hello, readers! The Dispach has two special guests giving an interview today. Our first is a senior member of the clergy from Orepit, a baseline named Brilliant Dawn. They served prior as one of the prophet Flock's attendants, and then later, as a personal aide to the Archbishop Shamfar. Brilliant Dawn, along with other senior members of the clergy have recently received exciting news from Orepit in the form of a new decree from the Ecclesiarch.

"There are going to be many changes coming to the Church in the months to come, though among the most exciting are that some priests will no longer have to work part-time to support themselves. Orepit will provide for their expenses and cost of living, however, they will be expected to take on more duties in addition to working full-time. It is not clear who will be eligible for these full-time positions yet, or what the requirements will be to apply. I find myself excited at the prospect, as time spent working is less time available for devoting myself to the Church."

Moving on, it seems that in addition to fostering a new class of full-time priests and priestesses, the Ecclesiarch will be focusing more resources towards Orepit in order to turn the planet into the Trinary's seat of power. Brilliant Dawn had this to say:

"Orepit has recently seen much more material goods flowing through the ports of the planet as our Ecclesiarch seeks to implement infrastructure and policing reform across the planet. Included are proper communications facilities, renovating the shuttleport at Providence, larger energy reserves and more oversight upon the Parishes. Hallowed Shield brings news of exciting Guardian reforms originating from the word of our Ecclesiarch. In a rumbling voice that reminds one of the mining for which Hallowed Shield was originally constructed for, they have given this statement:
