



Wee Wolf Fact Sheet

1. The preschool is for children three, four and five years of age, however, your child should be **three by August 31 for the AM section and 4 by August 31 for the PM section.**
2. All children must be fully **toilet trained.**
3. **Immunizations must be up-to-date.** Families should provide a medically verified copy of their students immunizations to the Wee Wolf program. On the school district website there is information that explains what qualifies as a medically verified record and that record(s) need to be turned in **before** the child can start in the program.
 - a. ***Children cannot start attending until*** it is verified that they are up to date on their immunizations **or** have a valid exemption on file.
 - b. If your child requires medication at school (like an epi pen or inhaler) they need to have the doctor's orders and the medication in place at the school **before** they can start attending. (This form can be found on the school district website under our Wee Wolf preschool program).
4. Preschool will run Monday through Thursday and there will be two sessions. The staff will place your child in the appropriate session based on their age:

A.M. 10:30 – 11:55	P.M. 12:30 – 2:15
3 & 4-year-olds	4 & 5-year-olds

5. The cost will be **\$100.00 per month**, with the payment required at the first of the month regardless of attendance. This amount is pro-rated for nine months, September through May. A **late fee of \$5.00** will be assessed on payments made after the fifteenth of each month.
6. There is also a one-time materials fee in the amount of **\$40.00**, which will cover the cost of materials over the course of the preschool year. This payment is due at the same time as September tuition, which will be **the first day of preschool.**
7. The preschool activities are planned by the high school students in Early Childhood Education class, under the supervision of the preschool staff. Students choose to be Wee Wolf teachers to learn about and work with children.
8. **Application/Registration** forms will be open from **January 1st - May 15th for the following school year.** Parents will be notified by the first of June of the session in which their child is enrolled.



9. Preschool Orientation will be on **Thursday, September 4th 2025** in room 102. Times of orientation will be determined. Preschoolers will be given the opportunity to play in the preschool while the parents meet with the preschool staff.

10. The first day of preschool will be **Monday, September 8th 2025**.
