Art*	AVI1O	An opportunity to try new skills with different media. Drawing media: pencil, chalk, pen and ink. Learn how to draw 3D objects, clay jar with sculptural elements, landscape composition, printmaking, tempera painting and mixed media
Drama*	ADA1O	This course provides opportunities for students to explore dramatic form and techniques, using material from a wide range of sources and cultures. Students will use the elements of drama to examine situations and issues that are relevant to their lives. Students will create, perform, discuss and analyze drama and then reflect on the experiences to develop an understanding of themselves, the art form and the world around them.
Music*	AMU1O	This course emphasizes the creation and performance of music at a level consistent with previous experience and is aimed at developing technique, sensitivity, and imagination.
	AMR1O (Band)	Students can choose to earn additional credits by participating in Repertoire Band (AMR1O) if they are taking AMU1O
Dance*	ATC1O	Students will generate movement through structured and unstructured improvisation, demonstrate an understanding of safe practices with regard to themselves and others in the dance environment,
Technology and the Skilled Trades**	TAS1O	This hands-on course enables students to further explore the engineering design process. Students will design and safely create prototypes, products, and/or services, working with tools and technologies from various industries.
Building the Entrepreneurial Mindset	BEM1O	Students will learn what makes an entrepreneur thrive and the skills required to succeed in today’s business environment. This hands-on course will use business software and applications to help students plan and develop their entrepreneurial ideas and learn how to present them to a target audience.
Learning Strategies	GLE1OL	This course is offered through our Learning Support Centre intended for those students who have individual education plans and or have had curriculum modified to support their learning goals. This course focuses on strategies to help students become more independent, confident learners. (gr 8 teacher consultation is required)
