- Students must take assessments online as directed by teachers.
- Students must have daily interaction with teachers, support staff, and peers via online learning, email, google classroom etc.

Communication

Grading

- Students will check grades weekly.
- Plagiarism/Cheating/Copying will not be tolerated.
 - Plagiarism is when phrases -more than three consecutive words- from a source are identical in structure and are not cited.
- All work turned in <u>must have capitalization and punctuation</u> to receive full credit otherwise it will receive 70%.

Grading Policy

- 90-100% = A, 80-89% = B, 70-79% = C, 60-69% = D, 59 and below = F
 - Grades will not be rounded up
- Grades will come from daily attendance and participation, daily work, quizzes, tests, projects, and reports.
- No Extra Credit will be given.
