## How has the pilot gone? - Britannia Village

So it's gone really well so far.

We planned for this pilot a series of six lessons. And to start with we were just introducing them to the Picoh and how it works. And we showed them the footage from the space launch, which got them really excited and stimulated. Is it too late to drop out?

The first lesson was about actually connecting the Picoh.

So that it would work as they could control it, and the instructions were really clear on the Picoh website. So we followed those and it just worked.

Every single student in pairs. They could connect their Picoh to their Chromebooks and they could use scratch and we did a few simple explorations to start

Student:" So now I am going to put a wait block....'

So things like a score increasing or at taking someone's name. So they're already used to using scratch interfaces. So they took to it really quickly, and they understood how to control the Picoh because there's just an extra section, basically at the bottom of the scratch blocks where they're specific to the PECO. We looked at how they can turn their heads to the Picoh's and how they can blink and change their eye movements and change colours. And they just really enjoyed exploring all the different things they could make it do.
