Key Legal Guidelines and Policies

CIPA (Children’s Internet Protection Act)

Schools using AI tools must ensure content filtering and protection measures are in place to shield students from harmful or inappropriate online content.

COPPA (Children’s Online Privacy Protection Act)

AI tools that interact with or collect information from students under 13 require **verified parental consent** before any data collection occurs.

FERPA (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act)

Protects the confidentiality of student education records. AI use at ADP must not compromise student privacy or access sensitive data without parental consent. **Page not found**

IDEA (Individuals with Disabilities Education Act)

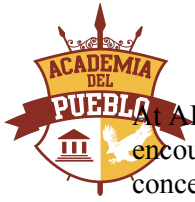
AI tools should support the unique needs of students with disabilities and align with their IEPs or 504 Plans. <https://sites.ed.gov/idea/>

Section 504

Ensures all AI applications used at ADP are accessible and inclusive for students with disabilities. **Page not found**

Arizona State Statutes Compliance

- **Protection of Pupil Rights Amendment (PPRA):** AI should not solicit sensitive student information without proper parental notice and consent. <https://studentprivacy.ed.gov/ppra>
- **ARS 15-142:** Generative AI tools must not expose student directory information or sensitive school property data.
