Future Simple будущее время	(+) will + V1 (-) will not (won't)+V1 (?) Will... V1	tomorrow, next year(month, weekend), in 2025	<i>They will play football tomorrow.</i> <i>They won't play football tomorrow.</i> <i>Will they play football tomorrow?</i>
