

Falcon Ridge Elementary 2023-2024 Land Trust Plan

Goal #1: Implement effective, research-based teaching and intervention strategies to assist all K-6 students in making at least one year's growth in reading.

Academic Area: Reading and Writing

Data Supporting:

The data collected from the Acadience Reading Benchmark assessments demonstrate an upward trend for students making typical or better growth in reading. In the 2021-22 school year, 60.4% of students had typical or better growth. We are on track in the 2022-2023 school year to exceed the previous year's growth. This data supports the need to continue the focus on reading achievement.

Measurements:

Teachers will monitor student progress towards growth by using Acadience benchmark scores and regular progress monitoring. Teachers will assess learning using common formative assessments to monitor progress of learning of the identified essential standards.

Action Plan Steps:

1. Funding will be used to hire an certified teacher as an interventionist and 3 paraprofessionals, who will provide remediation and acceleration instruction in reading.

Planned Expenditures:

1. Salaries and benefits for teacher & paraprofessionals \$90,589

Goal #2: Implement effective, research-based personalized and project-based learning opportunities to assist all K-6 students in making at least one year's growth in math and science.

Academic Area: Math and Science

Data Supporting:

The data collected from the Acadience Math Benchmark assessments for K-2 grades demonstrate a downward trend in math achievement. In the 2021-22 school year, there was negative growth in all three grade levels. Using our 2021-22 RISE math data for grades 3-6, it demonstrates minimal growth with 35.3% of students at proficiency. The 2021-22 RISE Science data for grades 3-6 also demonstrates minimal growth with 44.1% of students at proficiency. These are areas we need to focus and create change.

Measurements: Teachers will monitor student progress in using Acadience math scores, progress monitoring through the use of common formative assessments along with a change in the Tier 1 mathematical instruction.

Action Plan Steps:

1. Funding will be used to hire a certified teacher as an interventionist, who will provide remediation instruction in math.
2. Funding will be used to provide supplies for STEM to enhance learning in the areas of math and science.
