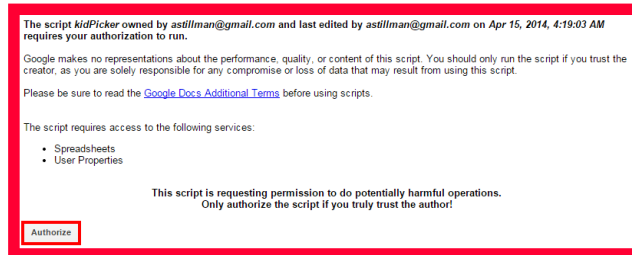


kidPicker

kidPicker is a tool that equitably randomizes the student selection process, allowing a teacher to maximize the spread of students selected on the same day. It also tracks simple teacher scorings (1,2,3) in a Google Spreadsheet. Once set up, you can access kidPicker from a computer, mobile device, or tablet. Follow the instructions below to use kidPicker!

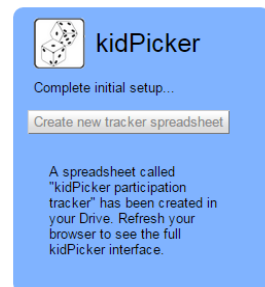
1. Go to: bit.ly/kidpicker
2. Click “Authorize.”



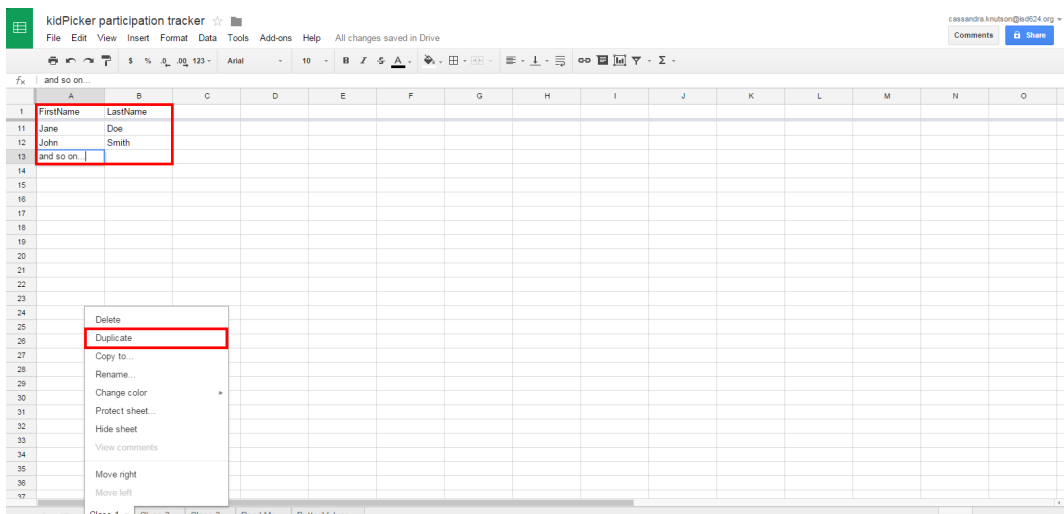
3. Click “Create new tracker spreadsheet.”



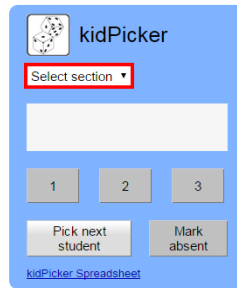
4. A spreadsheet will be created in your drive called “kidPicker participation tracker.”



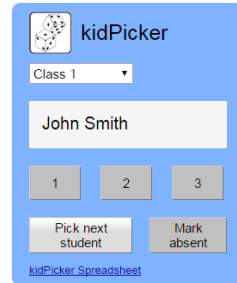
5. Go to your drive and open that spreadsheet.
6. Add the first and last names of your students in each class. You can navigate to different classes by selecting the “Class 1” and “Class 2” tabs at the bottom of the spreadsheet. You can add more classes by clicking the down arrow next to “Class 1,” selecting “Duplicate,” and renaming the duplicate sheet “Class 3.”



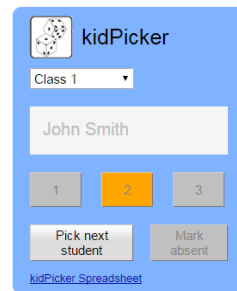
7. Once your students are added go to bit.ly/kidpicker again.
8. The kidPicker application will open. Select a class.



9. Once a class is selected you can select “Pick next student” to pick a random student.



10. You can score the student 1, 2, or 3 based on their participation.



11. Their score will appear in the spreadsheet.
