We plan to have approximately 60 pages in this issue. To reach that goal, we are seeking **25** artists, **5** writers, and **3** merch artists.

C Artists

- Artists are required to submit three samples of their best work, a link to their portfolio (instagram, twitter, main art website, etc.), and links to their respective social media accounts. Samples can come from any fandom for as long as we can judge your skills from the submission.
- All three samples must be fully colored pieces with rendered backgrounds. If the sample is in traditional format, it is highly recommended to scan the piece.
- © Skills must include a solid understanding of anatomy, line weight, color theory, perspective, composition, gesture, etc.
- **Two or three prompts** you intend to work on should they be accepted.

Writers

- Writers are required to submit **three samples of their best work**, a link to their **portfolio** (instagram, twitter, main art website, etc.), and links to their respective **social media accounts**. Samples can come from any fandom for as long as we can judge your skills from the submission.
- All three writing samples must be under 2,000 words each. Excerpts of larger works are acceptable, though we ask at least one sample to be a one-shot.
- © Proficient understanding of the English language, grammatical structure, and the use of figurative and rhetorical devices.
- Two or three one-sentence prompts you intend to work on should you be accepted.

Merch Artists

Writers are required to submit **three samples of their best work**, a link to their **portfolio** (instagram, twitter, main art website, etc.), and links to

their respective **social media accounts**. Samples can come from any fandom for as long as we can judge your skills from the submission.

Two or three suggestions of merch you intend to work on and a brief description of the design that goes together with the piece.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is this a for profit or charity zine?

« A Moment in Eternity is a for profit zine, meaning all profits generated
after the production and shipping costs will be split equally among all the
contributors.

Will there be NSFW content?

© The zine will be kept strictly Safe For Work and available to audiences of all ages. Naturally, this includes a maximum rating of PG-13 and or TV-14.

• How and what can I apply as?

© Slots for artists, writers, and merch artists will be open on the release of the Information and Guidelines and the contributor applications.

Scheduled period for this would be Nov 22nd - Jan 8. For further updates, follow our social media for further details.

What to do if I need to drop out?

© We understand that life is unpredictable, so our advice is to drop out before the first and second check in, which is on Feb 12thth and March

12th accordingly. If the event is later than that, it is still recommended to let us know as soon as possible. Note that the dates above are subjected to change due to unexpected events.

What are the requirements for artists?

 \mathbb{C} We are in search of 25-30 artists. Each size will be 6inx9in (5.8" x 8.3") at 300dpi. Artists must have proficient skills with anatomy, line weight, color theory, perspective, composition, gesture, etc.
