- 1 Egyptian Pharaonic civilization begins as a unified country.
- ~300 The Step-Pyramid of Djoser is constructed
- ~410 Sneferu, having built several not-quite-right pyramids, dies.
- ~450 Great Pyramid constructed
- ~815 Pepi II, longest-reigning monarch in Egyptian history, dies leaving a chaos of succession
- ~950 The First Intermediate Period ends and Egypt is re-unified
- ~1120 1160 Senworset III rules Egypt and launches several military campaigns against Nubia to expand Egyptian territory.
- ~1200 Queen Sobekneferu dies without leaving an heir. Rule passes to Amenemhat IV, 13th Dynasty. An independant 14th Dynasty emerges in the Delta (North)
- ~1350 13th Dynasty comes to an end after Hyksos kings conquer Memphis to create the 15th Dynasty.
- ~1450 Ahmose I expels the Hyksos and re-re-unifies Egypt. Start of New Kingdom and Dynasty 18.
- ~1520 1540 Hatshepsut is Pharaoh
- ~1540 1575 Thutmose III conducts 15 separate military campaigns in the Near East
- ~1650 Akhenaten becomes Pharaoh. Introduced monotheistic religion and builds a new city (Amarna)
- ~1680 Tutankhamun dies
- ~1720 Ramesses II 'The Great' ascends to the throne
- ~1740 The Egyptian-Hittite peace treaty between Ramesses II and Hattusilis III, possibly the world's first peace treaty, is signed
- ~1790 Ramesses II dies. Continuing confusion over succession with three separate sons ruling as Ramesses IV, VI, and VIII
- ~1920 Ramesses XI, last pharaoh of Dynasty 20, dies. High priests of Amun are de-facto rulers of Upper (south) Egypt, with the Lower (north) controlled by Smendes.

- ~2050 Egypt re-re-re-united by Shoshenq I
- ~2180 Egypt fractures into two states again. Civil war breaks out.
- ~2250 Nubian kings take over the rest of Egypt
- ~2335 Assyrian conquest of Egypt. Late Period begins.
- ~2665 Alexander the Great conquers Egypt. Ptolemies installed as ruling Dynasty.
- ~2930 Cleopatra VII Philoraptor is born
- ~2950 Cleopatra VII becomes ruler of Egypt
- ~2970 Cleopatra VII dies. Egypt falls to Roman rule. End of Pharaonic civilization.
- ~3640 Muslim conquest of Egypt
