

Video lesson 2: Role play cards

What do I need to know about the role play?

- It is the second part of the speaking exam (after **Read aloud**).
- There are **10** possible settings.
- The teacher speaks first.
- You will say something for each of the **five** numbered items.
- Speak in the present tense, or use a conditional like *je voudrais*.
- You will need to ask **two** questions.
- You can choose between using the informal *tu* form or the formal *vous* form (though you don't have to!) to ask your questions.
- You will answer **one question** about something in the **future**.

Will last 1-1.5 minutes

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Cinema/ theatre /concert hall	Café or restaurant
Hotel	Campsite
Dr surgery or hospital	In town
Tourist office	Sport/ leisure centre
Train station	Shop/ market/ shopping centre

What should I do when I get my roleplay card?

- Identify the different skills - is it a future tense? Am I asking a question?
- Work out what you want to say in English - do you have all of the vocabulary you need in your head?
- Think about the some core modal phrases / sentence starters you can confidently use to get you going.

<u>Je voudrais</u>	
<u>Je vais</u>	
<u>J'ai l'intention de</u>	
<u>Je suis</u>	

Setting: At the campsite

Scenario:

- You are at a campsite in France
- The teacher will play the part of the employee and speak first.
- The teacher will ask questions **in French**. You must answer **in French**
- Say a few words or a short phrase/sentence for each prompt.
- One word answers are not sufficient for full marks .

Task:

2. Say how many people it is for
3. Say what you are planning on doing in the area
4. Ask for a recommendation for where to eat
5. Ask about facilities at the campsite
