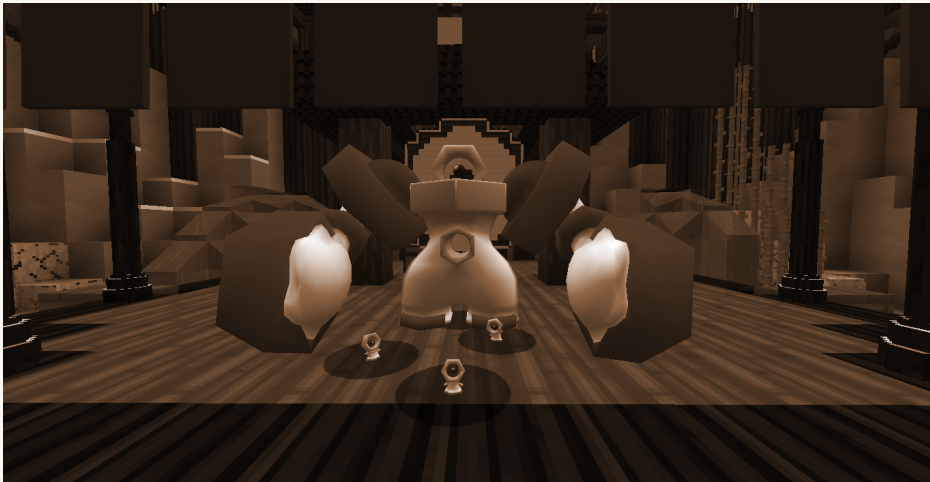

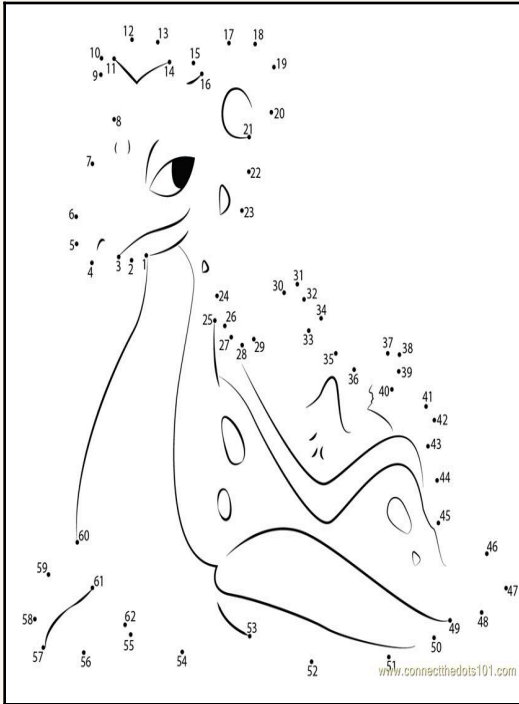


### #385 Jirachi
