If you haven't already, parents and guardians will need to create an account with the Upper Grand before they can download their child's progress card. To create a Parent Portal account, click on the link for your child's school. Parents/guardians can create their account provided they have an email on record with the school. Once your account is activated, you will see each of your children listed.
