VIII. FINAL BOARD COMMENTS

- Trustee Bailey – thanked Cathy Kubiak for the in-depth data rich report and said the questions is now, what do we do with the data. She thanked the Student Alliance leadership for “stepping up”. Trustee Bailey thanked those that put the fall semester opening day together as the speaker was in-line with what we are doing.
- Trustee Verburg – commented on the commitment of the Student Alliance leadership and new Director, Lina Blair as he has attended several of their meetings and is impressed with their work.
- Trustee James – thanked Cathy for her report and answering all the Board’s questions. She went on to express how impressed she was with the support that was given to a student she brought to the M-Tec Center as Trustee James has been working with four young adults to get them enrolled for fall. She went on to say she wanted to publically thank Chris Arnold who recently retired from GRCC for all her work she has done for the institution and community.
- Trustee Bristol – shared a chair that her granddaughter made while attending a summer manufacturing camp the M-Tec Center offered. She went on to say what a great experience her granddaughter had and thanked the M-Tec folks for offering this kind of opportunity for young boys and girls.
- Trustee Stewart – truly appreciated the information that was shared and stated the take-away is the institution is genuinely interested in people. Trustee Stewart went on to express his concern with the institution complying with the recent (May 2016) directive by President Obama that public schools allow transgender students to use bathrooms that correspond with their gender identity rather than the gender listed on their birth certificate.
- Chairperson Bleke – thanked the Geography department for sharing “Geography Lives” newsletter with the Board as he felt it was professional and informative. He went on to say that the Board will discuss Trustee Stewart’s concern.
- Trustee Koetje – asked not to lose sight of the good work being done at the institution, stating one of the biggest things is allowing people a second chance. Trustee Koetje went on to say as he works with people that are looking and needing a second chance he finds so many examples of “second chances” at this institution, which continues to offer with risk, yet still continues to give.
