

The [Student Governance Code of Conduct](#) provides a way for student representatives to be held accountable and hold other representatives accountable. The formal complaint process ensures that complaints are addressed fairly, impartially, and respectfully to all parties. We strive to resolve complaints as quickly as possible and ensure that you receive a clear response to your concerns.

This process is for complaints related to the conduct of student representatives under UASU involved in recognized Student Representative Associations or in Students' Council and its committees. A list of Student Representative Associations is provided in [Regulation 150.07](#). Per section 09 of the Code of Conduct, only student representatives may complete this form.

Instructions:

1. Fill out this form in its entirety. Be concise, provide factual details, and attach additional supporting evidence.
2. Formal complaints under this procedure are accepted via email at governance@uasu.ca. Please write on the subject line "Confidential - Speaker of Students' Council" and include the of any supporting documents as attachments to the email.
3. Complainants can expect to receive confirmation of receipt of the complaint from the Speaker of the Students' Council. You may be asked to provide additional information before the process moves forward.
