

SENIORS 2027

Homecoming:

-Homecoming this year is Friday, October 23rd. There is no school on that day. The parade will be at 1:30 that afternoon. This year's homecoming theme is "Broadway". See class officers for details on times and the location for float building.

Senior Night:

-Tuesday, September 22nd at 6:00 pm, with Kirk Rushing. Seniors and senior parents are welcome. Mr. Rushing will talk about FAFSA (Federal Application for Federal Student Aid) and how to apply. There will also be several universities setting up booths if you are interested in talking to a representative and/or getting more info about that university. See Mrs. Feroli for more details.

FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)

-Kirk Rushing will be at the high school all day to help seniors with FAFSA on a date TBA (sometime late Fall). Make sure to see Mrs. Feroli to set up an appointment time if you are interested!

Senior pictures:

-Senior picture day this year is Tuesday, October 13th. Seniors will be dismissed to the library in groups to have their pictures taken. All seniors must take their SENIOR PICTURES on the senior camera to be included on the panel either that day, or the day of picture retakes on Tuesday, October 27th. There is NO sitting fee!! (see Mrs. Leigh Ann for more information and pricing).

Caps/Gowns:

-Caps and gowns will be ordered on Friday, September 4th at the high school. Representatives will be here to get gown sizes and to help with ordering. They will come on Monday, August 31st to pass out order forms and go over pricing during 4th hour.

-Estimate:

***NOTE:** Get your caps and gowns ordered ASAP...the price will start going up by the middle of September!!!!

Senior Budget:

- This year's senior class has a carryover from last year of about \$4,000. This will be used for things such as homecoming supplies/materials, senior T-shirts, senior assembly items (like roses), graduation stuff, as well as any senior picnic at the end of the year.
- Senior panel copies and 2027 yearbooks will NOT be available until after the next school year begins. Watch the marquee, newspaper, or school website for details.

Senior College Days:

- All PHS seniors are allowed **ONE** exempted college day this year.
- This can be taken all in one day or two half-days.
- Seniors **MUST** notify Mrs. Feroli or Mr. Hammer at least 2 DAYS beforehand.

Prom:

- This year's prom will be on Saturday, April 10th at the Grand Canadian Theatre Time TBA. See Mrs. Leigh Ann for more details.

Graduation/Senior Assembly:

- Senior Assembly is Thursday, May 20th (afternoon) in H.S. gym
- Graduation practice & Senior Walk-Thru is Friday, May 21st (morning) in the H.S. gym (breakfast may be provided)
- Graduation is Friday evening, May 21st (6:00 pm – 7:30 pm) in the H.S. gym.
- Seniors who cannot participate in either of these events are those who:
 - (1) **do not complete graduation requirements* prior to those dates**
 - (2) **still owe dues (see Mr. O'Neal)**
 - (3) **have not completed and turned in their senior check-out sheets**

(*Seniors 2027 may still participate in both senior assembly and graduation if they are within ½ credit of meeting requirements AND show proof of enrollment to complete this ½ credit.)
