
Hike the Sespe River Trail to Bear Creek Camp! Yea May 21-22, 2022

The CA Department of Fish and Wildlife will have its annual Debra Takayama Memorial Junior Pheasant Hunt on the morning of February 5 near Lake Cachuma. There are two ways you can participate:

1. **(registration closed)** If you were under 16 on July 1, 2021, you may register to participate in the hunt. This is an excellent introduction to bird hunting, with CDFW officers and other trained personnel there to help you. You would need your hunter safety training and a Junior Hunter License, and a 12 or 20 gauge shotgun, to participate in the hunt. If you have little or no experience in shotgun shooting, you may ask Dr. Benoit, ASM to conduct some practice sessions before February 5. He can also teach the hunter safety course, or you can take it online.

To register for the hunt, go to: www.debshunt.org. REGISTER SOON, it will be oversubscribed!

2. ***This is also a service opportunity.*** Whether or not you are hunting, you may work with Mr. Patton, ASM to provide a skill session teaching some of the great lashing, knot and other skills to the hunters who are waiting for their turn to shoot. The 1923 movie The Ten Commandments was filmed here, and the gigantic sets are still buried somewhere in the dunes.

Then we can wander back through the dunes to the cars. It's a fantastic place to visit, that most people in Santa Barbara County don't even know exists!
