





## How to Self-Enroll 2025 Summer Success with Apex

Students may choose any content to practice this summer and self-enroll with their Campus eCodes. Students can access Apex on their phones, ipads, chromebooks, laptops, etc.


<p>1. Go to the <b>Students</b> tab on the Frisco ISD website and select the <b>Student Portal</b>.</p>	
<p>2. Login to the student portal using your <b>FISD username and password</b>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Username</b>: student ID number</li> <li>• <b>Password</b>: mm/dd/yyyy birthdate</li> </ul>	
<p>3. Search and select the <b>Clever</b> tile.</p>	
<p>4. Click on <b>Login with Google</b>.</p> <p>5. Enter your <b>FISD google credentials</b>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Username</b>: FISD google account</li> <li>• <b>Password</b>: FISD password</li> </ul>	
<p>6. Select the <b>Apex</b> tile at the bottom of the page.</p>	

7. If this is your first time to login to Apex, you will be prompted to read and accept the **Student Code of Conduct**.





8. On your student dashboard, you should see a list of your pre-existing classes.






10. Enter your **Campus Enrollment Code** and click **Next**.

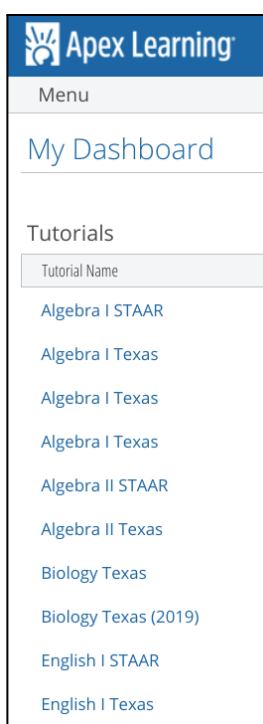
11. Once you enter the enrollment code, click **Enroll**.

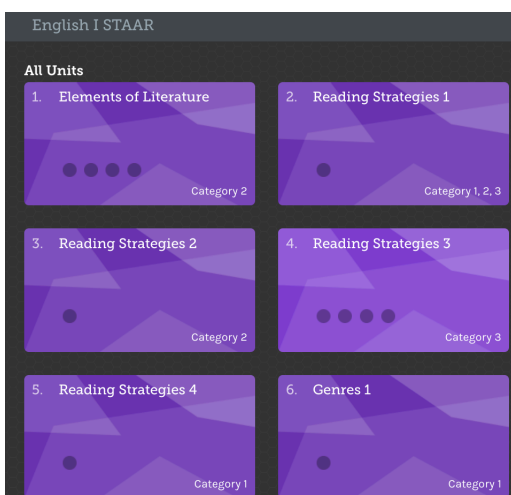
