2	Adopted container gardening (for schools without available space/flooded area)			
3	Adopted the "crop museum" technology approved by the International Institute for Rural Reconstruction in order to promote crop diversification and improve sufficiency on the supply of seeds and seedlings.			
4	Established a vegetable garden as a ready source of vegetables for their supplementary feeding.			
5	Propagated vegetables to address micronutrient deficiencies:			
	✓ Sources of proteins – leguminous vegetables such as beans, mungo, peas, etc.			
	✓ Sources of calories/energy – root crops such as gabi, camote, cassava, etc.			
	✓ Sources of Vitamin A and Iron – leafy green vegetables such as tops of gabi, malunggay, saluyot, alugbati, kangkong, sili, kulitis, pechay, etc.			
6	Maintained and sustained thru establishment of nurseries, seed production in partnership with stakeholders.			
	Planted at least 50 malunggay trees within the school.			
7	Sold excess vegetables in the community as part of the school's income-generating project for the procurement of feeding ingredients, garden tools and other garden inputs.			
8	Used alternative gardening methods such as hanging or containerized gardening using tires, empty bottles, recyclable/biodegradable brown plastic bags and so on.			
9	Used organic fertilizer and inputs (animal wastes, chicken dung, crop residues, food wastes, vermicast, etc) to enhance soil fertility and improve production yield.			
10	Secured the garden area to protect the crops from stray animals.			
11	Availability of one set of garden tools which may include spade, grab hoe, shovel, sprinkler, trowels, digging bar, rake, bolo, etc, shall be required.			
12	Availability of improvised garden tools.			
13	Included/involved PTA and stakeholders to maintain the school garden every summer as a measure to sustain the garden, and to prepare for the opening of the school year.			
14	Encouraged the establishment of home/community vegetable garden.			
15	Taught the nutritional dimension of food production and related messages to learners through integration in appropriate subject areas (e.g. Health and EPP/TLE Curriculum).			



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16	Pursued the effort to increase the vegetable production and consumption vigorously thru quad media like print, broadcast, TV and social media.			
17	Conducted poster-making, slogan writing, and cooking contests at the school level during Nutrition Month Celebration and other School celebrations.			
18	Designated a School GPP Coordinator.			
19	GPP Coordinator worked hand in hand with the feeding coordinator in the preparation of school food production/school feeding plan in the effort to address malnutrition among learners.			
20	GPP Coordinator prepared planting calendars at the beginning of each school year in order to ensure a year-round supply of harvest for feeding thru a Gantt Chart.			
21	Submitted progress report to SDO.			
22	Included the GPP in the School Improvement Plan (SIP).			
23	Documented best practices for possible adoption in other schools, i.e. Bio-intensive gardening, Multiple cropping system, organic farming, nursery establishment and management, composting, container/urban gardening, etc.
