3.	Approval of May Meeting Minutes – Chelsey Stevens	Last month's meeting minutes were distributed prior to today's meeting for approval.	Meeting Minutes approved by all.
4.	Trail Development and Planning Committee Report – Tom Daniels	- The focus has been on volunteer hours reporting. We are working on getting people trained. - Updating FTA trail manual. - We hope to have the manual completed by the end of the year. - Trail Master terminology has been deleted from the trail manual.	- Trail Manual is still in the process of completion. - We are waiting on trail manual feedback from staff.
5.	Chapter Council Committee – Karl Byers	17 of the 19 chapters were present at the last Chapter Council Committee. - Working on the Activity Leader Training PowerPoint to be utilized by all chapters. - Revised and distributed new Chapter Assessment Tools. We will use this to help each other out as chapters. Chapters who are strong in one category will assist chapters who are weak in the same category. - There is some confusion on the chapter website membership renewal online. Is there still a Family Membership for example? - It was suggested that folks who donate \$1000 receive recognition (A plaque, for example). - There is a cost share agreement with the Florida Trail for Tents and other marketing tools. The cost is high, but the quality is also high. This cost also included pop-up banners. There is an additional cost if there is any chapter specific customization included. - Individual chapters are currently having to print their own marketing materials and being reimbursed for the cost.	- Individual Chapters to complete the Chapter Assessment Tool. - Membership contribution brackets were changed to make it less confusing and to allow people to contribute less or more depending on their ability regardless of if they are a family or individual. - Motion was made for the advancement committee to Discuss our current membership options for review. – All were in favor. - The FTA is trying to get a fedex printing account set up so the association is billed for marketing materials, but individual chapters can order.

The Finance Committee Charter was reviewed and approved by the committee itself and approved by the BOD in this meeting. – All were in favor

Governance Committee – Maria Llornes	- The Personal Safety Policy was reviewed, and the governance committee has provided comments. - The Executive Evaluation plan was discussed and refined for use in the next evaluation. - Board transparency has been discussed and is being evaluated by the governance committee. - Non-Board Members in committees should be signing the same ethics documentation and issues that may arise with the number of non-BOD members within a committee. - Working on the strategic plan implementation. - BOD discussed the executive committee and wants further definition on what the executive committee is responsible for as we are currently not following the bylaws in place. - BOD meeting minutes are available on the board website for board members only. Publicizing BOD minutes is a topic in review withing the governance committee.	- Governance Committee to discuss the roles and responsibilities of the executive committee. - FTA will be developing an Incident Reporting System. Governance to work with the FTA staff to develop a system to limit legal liability. - Maria made a few edits to the Safety Policy (Line 1, Line 6, Line 8). The Safety Policy approved by all to include Maria's edits.
