I <u>always</u> wake up at 7:30 am. - just a habit

He is <u>always / continually</u> taking long showers. - annoying habit of someone

PASSIVE

PAST SIMPLE -> WAS/WERE + P.P.
PAST CONT. -> WAS/WERE + BEING + P.P.
PAST PERFECT -> HAD + BEEN + P.P.
