If you work your way through these following pages, you will be prepared when PowerSchool registration goes live on February 24 and can use these pages to guide you through online registration, item by item. The PowerSchool registration pages will stay open until March 10. Parents are strongly encouraged to check to see how their students registered by that date. After that time, students and parents will not be able to make course request changes within PowerSchool except by contacting their counselor.

Summer school registration is different and separate from PowerSchool registration. The summer school link will be emailed out to all TC families on February 26 but will not open until March 4 at 7 PM. Summer school registration WITH REQUIRED PAYMENT CONFIRMATION will begin on March 4 at 7 PM. The full payment for each class registration will be charged on the parent/guardian's corresponding April tuition payment date. Class sizes are limited, so registrations are time-stamped in the order in which they are received. Unless the course is canceled by the school, all summer school payments are non-refundable.

Details regarding summer school are included in the 2025-26 curriculum guide.

# Welcome to the Timothy Christian High School Class Registration System for 2025-26

Welcome, current TCHS JUNIORS, to your PowerSchool registration site. It's the last time you need to do this! If you have problems while registering, please email Mrs. Raley (<a href="mailto:raley@timothychristian.com">raley@timothychristian.com</a>) or see Mrs. Raley or Mr. Huizinga. Once you finish, please check your registration for accuracy. If you made a mistake, you can go back into your registration to correct it.

Reminder: You're required to sign up for 6 credits each semester. PowerSchool will allow you to register for as many as 8.0 credits, BUT this is only possible if you fill up all 7 periods for BOTH semesters AND take *Jazz Ensemble* and *Chamber Singers* all year (or *Weightlifting* during semester 1) in zero hour. Most of you will not fit that description. You also will not sign up for study hall or Guided Study. If you have open slots (not counting zero hour) in your school day, they will be filled in later with either study hall or Guided Study.

Click on the pencil box on the right side of the page to select a class. **Red exclamation** marks mean you MUST make a choice. **Green check marks** mean you are not required to select a course from this item number (or it's automatically selected for you).

#### 1. 12 AP English Literature: S1

If you do not plan to register for AP English Literature, move to Item 3. Otherwise, please sign up for semester 1 of this year-long course.

#### 5. 12 Math: S1

To meet Timothy's graduation requirement, you must minimally take <u>3 years</u> of math (including algebra and geometry). MOST 4-year colleges REQUIRE that you also have completed Algebra 2 (which includes trigonometry). If you are college-bound, any math class beyond *Algebra 2* (or *H Algebra 2*) is entirely your choice, but colleges encourage you to continue and *selective* colleges may recommend or *require* you to continue. The more math you have under your belt, the better off you are! If still uncertain, please talk to your math teacher.

Your next math class very much depends on which math class you are enrolled in for this year. Your math registration is *subject to change*, depending upon your math grades for the rest of the year and any input from your current math teacher.

If you have met the 3-year math requirement and do NOT wish to enroll in another math course for your senior year, you may move on to Item 9. 12 Science: S1.

\*\*\*If you have experienced success this year in *Algebra 2* or *H Algebra 2* and would like to continue your math studies, enroll in *Pre-Calculus* or *H Pre-Calculus* for your senior year.

<sup>\*\*\*</sup>If you are currently in *AP Calculus AB* and would like to continue your math studies, you could potentially register for 1 to 2 free semesters of college coursework (not necessarily in math) at Elmhurst University (your schedule will need to be flexible, and you must drive yourself). Or, you could register for college dual enrollment courses (for college credit) or online AP math-related coursework (for HS credit)—these have a cost and will be paid directly to the appropriate college or school. You can also talk to Mr. Piersma about taking a *Thinkwell* Calculus online course (for **no** credit) at your cost (\$190) to prepare for the AP Calculus BC exam. For now, please choose according to your interest or move on to item 7

#### 11. 12 Soc Studies: AP HG 1, Wld History, AP Psychology S1

3.0 social studies credits are required to graduate. If you took *AP Human Geography* or *World History* as a sophomore, you have met that requirement already. You can skip the remaining social studies classes.

If you'd like to take just a semester of *World History*, make sure you look at the course descriptions because semesters 1 and 2 cover different geographical regions and periods of history. You may take either a semester or a full year of this class.

If you want to take *AP Human Geography* or *T IS in AP Psychology* (an online class with additional tuition paid separately to the online program), these are for the entire year and require a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0. Both mean you will be taking the national AP exam in May.

While you're having so much fun deciding, you can even take BOTH AP Human Geography AND World History.

Two more classes are coming up shortly as still more social studies options: Psychology or Economics.

<sup>\*\*\*</sup>Select *Spanish 4* OR *H Spanish 4* as your 4th year option if you have a "B" or better in *Spanish 3* this year. Your teacher can advise you.

<sup>\*\*\*</sup>Select *AP Spanish* if you have an "A" in *H Spanish* and are ready for the expectations of an AP class. You will ALSO need to have your teacher's recommendation.

TRANSFER students must have EITHER an art OR music credit to graduate. If you do already, you may move on. If you want a single-semester art class to meet this requirement (*Art 1* is the prerequisite for all other art classes at TCHS), you will find it listed under "General Electives" farther down. *Contemporary Musicianship* also meets the fine arts requirement, is a semester class, and can be found under "General Electives," but please read the course description as it is very specific about which students should register.

\*\*\*If you are planning to enroll in choir, band, or orchestra, it is expected that you will be enrolled for the <a href="ENTIRE">ENTIRE</a> year.

\*\*\*If you want to sing, enroll in *Mixed Choir* or *Concert Chorale*. Did you audition with Mrs. Lanenga? (You will need to for Chorale.) If you don't get into *Concert Chorale*, you could sign up for *Mixed Choir* instead.

\*\*\*If you would like to participate in both choir and band or choir and orchestra, make the appropriate selection (BUT the music teachers make the final decision).

If you want to be in honors Chorale, Band, or Orchestra, you will be required to sign a contract next fall and then you will be registered for the honors credit.
