- 5 To be taxed with Mary his ^a<u>espoused</u> wife, being great with child.
- 6 And so it was, that, while they were there, the days were accomplished that she should be delivered.
- 7 And she brought forth her ^a<u>firstborn</u> son, and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger; because there was no room for them in the ^binn.

- 11 For unto you is aborn this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord.
- 12 And this *shall be* a ^asign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger.
- 13 And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying,
- 14 aGlory to God in the highest, and on earth bpeace, good will toward men.

- 20 And the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told unto them.
