

# **Summer Music Opportunities for school-aged/college students**

## **Local chamber music/band/orchestra camps; options for players of all levels (generally in order of advancing playing level)**

**Laurel School of Music (St. Paul):** <https://www.laurelschoolofmusic.org/camps>

- **Summer music camp:**

- Rising 1<sup>st</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> graders, no prior experience required: Students explore their musical knowledge and ability through classes, creative play, and presentations by renowned professionals. No prior musical experience required! Students participate in core classes including choir and musicianship, and choose from electives for smaller classes offering more individualized attention. Options include include songwriting, beginning and intermediate ukulele, handbells and more!

- **Band camp:**

- For rising 4th through 7th graders who are at the beginner or intermediate level on a band instrument. Students should have at least one school year of playing experience on their instrument. Students will spend our time working as a large group, and splitting into woodwind and brass sections to work more closely on tricky parts of the music. The schedule is rounded out with rhythm games, musicianship classes, and more to develop musical and collaboration skills.

# Non-local flute camps for advanced flutists

## Flute Workshop at the Ohio State University: <https://music.osu.edu/outreach/ysmp/flute-workshop>

- For students entering grades 9–12 in the 2026–2027 school year, and 2026 high school graduates.
- No audition required. Register by May 26, 2026.
- Students will participate in master classes taught by Professor Katherine Borst Jones and guests, technique classes, private lessons, solo night, faculty and counselor recitals, flute choir and twice-daily coached small flute ensembles. Enjoy a finale concert featuring all participants, free and open to the public.

**Alexa Still: Flute Boot Camp at Oberlin College (Ohio):**

- Open to 12 advanced flutists who have not yet graduated from high school looking for a week of vigorous work on their flute playing in a friendly, supportive environment. Students will receive two lessons with Professor Still: one 45-minute private lesson and one open master class lesson. Also included are daily warm-up sessions, technical workshops, coachings, ensemble work and rehearsal with pianist Hyunsoo Kim. Technical workshops include a session with body mapping expert Kelly Mollnow-Wilson, orchestral mock audition (performance participation optional), college audition workshop and more. An optional concert opportunity will conclude the camp.
