One of their services is in-vitro fertilization (IVF) treatment. Here, it takes seven weeks to complete this treatment, and they're very efficient.

It will cost you around £5,000–£8,000, depending on your situation. Unfortunately, their pricing is more expensive compared to others.

You will also have the option to use eggs from donors if you want or need to.

However, there were issues where they were careless with scheduling. For one of the customers, this messed up their egg collection date, which is crucial in the IVF process.

However, there are complaints from clients that the staff members lack empathy. According to them, the representative kept their camera off while explaining that the patient couldn't have a baby.

There are also concerns about them not providing regular updates to their patients.

Whether you need help getting pregnant, get a fertility test, or preserve your fertility, they can assist you with ease.


One of their services is called Mild IVF. This is a safer and kinder treatment.

On top of this, their consultants can also provide conflicting advice when you return for a follow-up appointment.

The first one is reversible vasectomy. This operation is performed on men to prevent pregnancy.


As for women, you can also choose between short-term and long-term contraception.

One of their doctors, Dr. Edmond Edi-Osagie, is a private gynecologist with rich experience in the field. He's a fertility, fibroid, and endometriosis specialist that can cater to almost all reproductive concerns.

Of course, this includes cases that deal with fertility.

One of their services is full baseline investigations. Here, both partners are thoroughly tested.

With this process, you'll be able to assess the state of your fertility. They'll examine you and your partner manually and through high-tech equipment.

They have machines for efficient ultrasound, blood tests, and more.

However, their consultation fee starts at £250. This is expensive compared to the average consultation fee.

On top of that, they also don't provide estimates for their IVF treatments. However, their patients shared that this is also more pricey compared to others.

There are also reports that they are unresponsive to online inquiries. It would be better to call them instead.

## How much does private fertility treatment cost in the UK?

The costs vary depending on the services that you need. However, prepare to shell out between £1,500 and £5,000 for treatment fees.

This doesn't include other services and treatment requirements such as drugs.

## Is in-vitro fertilization successful in the first attempt?

It's possible for in-vitro fertilization to work during the first attempt. However, according to studies, only 55% of women under the age of 35 get successful results on their first IVF.

## Can you have IVF at 45?

Yes, it's possible to get IVF at 45. However, you have to keep in mind that the quality of the egg declines.

Once you reach 30, it would be harder to get positive results.

# Is IVF your baby?

Technically, yes. The baby will be conceived using your egg and your partner's sperm.

In other cases, it can also involve cells from donors.
